Evans to learn new innovative approaches from Swiss and Swedish health systems

Edmonton... Health and Wellness Minister Iris Evans will travel to Switzerland and Sweden this month to study their health systems and meet with government and health officials.

Evans will arrive in Switzerland on June 11 along with a study group, at the invitation and expense of the Swiss government. Accompanying Evans will be members of Capital Health, the Calgary Health Region, the College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta, and Alberta Health and Wellness department officials.

The group will discuss important health issues such as health system governance, accountability and financing, wellness, workforce, innovative ways to deliver care, and pharmaceutical policy. Following three days of meetings, Evans will take a tour of a Swiss health facility.

On June 16, Evans and her executive assistant will travel from Switzerland to Sweden, where she will meet with a number of government and health care officials including researchers from the Karolinska Institute, whose research accounts for 40 per cent of all the academic medical research carried out in Sweden.

"This trip presents a wonderful opportunity for us to explore the challenges we share, but more importantly, it will give us the valuable experience of learning from the innovative approaches that these countries have taken towards finding solutions," said Evans.

Evans will return to Edmonton on June 21.

The total cost of the trip for the minister and her executive assistant, excluding the Switzerland-hosted portion, is estimated at \$9800 including airfare, meals and accommodation.
