Highway 41 near Elk Point sealed with chips

Elk Point... Ten kilometres of Highway 41 are scheduled for seal coat construction on July 4. The section extends from Moosehills Road to North of Junction Highway 29. Chip seal coat construction involves the application of a wearing surface to the roadway. Work is expected to be completed by July 6, weather permitting.

Pilot vehicles will guide traffic through construction where the highway speed is reduced to 50 kilometres per hour. Motorists are asked to use caution in these areas and to obey all signs and flag persons.
