Highway 35 bridge construction near High Level set to begin

High Level... Construction of bridges on Highway 35 at Camp Creek, south of Indian Cabins, and Bede Creek, south of High Level, will begin July 9.

Detours will be in place 24 hours a day for the duration of construction. No lane width restrictions are anticipated on the detours. Motorists are asked to use caution in these areas and obey reduced speed limits and other traffic control devices.

The existing culverts at both sites are being replaced with concrete bridges. The combined total project cost is approximately \$3.5 million. Construction will be completed by the end of October, weather permitting.
