Highway 857 near Smoky Lake to be chip sealed

Bellis... Twenty kilometres of Highway 857 are scheduled for seal coat construction starting July 8. The section of Highway 857 where the work is taking place extends from Highway 652 to Highway 28 near Bellis, which is 24 kilometres east of Smoky Lake. Work is expected to be completed by July 10, weather permitting.

Chip seal coat construction involves the application of a wearing surface to the roadway.

Pilot vehicles will guide traffic through construction areas where the speed limit is reduced to 50 kilometres per hour. Motorists are asked to use caution in these areas and to obey all signs and flag persons.
