Highway 663 near Boyle sealed with chips

Boyle... Eighteen kilometres of Highway 663 is scheduled for seal coat construction on July 11. The construction area extends from Boyle to west of Caslan. Chip seal coat construction involves the application of a wearing surface to the roadway. Work is expected to be completed by July 13, weather permitting.

Pilot vehicles will guide traffic through construction where the highway speed is reduced to 50 kilometres per hour. Motorists are asked to use caution in these areas and to obey all signs and flag persons.
