Bridge being replaced on Highway 37 north of St. Albert

St. Albert... Traffic on Highway 37 over Riviere Qui Barre, approximately eight kilometres east of Calahoo, will be detoured onto a temporary bridge structure between July 18 to September 16, weather permitting. The original bridge, built in 1964, will be replaced with a new permanent bridge structure at a cost of \$3.9 million.

The speed limit within the construction zone will be reduced to 50 kilometres per hour and motorists are asked to use caution in the area.
