Sherwood Park sign repairs on Highway 216 ramp leading to Highway 16

Sherwood Park... Motorists traveling north on Highway 216 connecting to Highway 16 eastbound will experience disruptions for two nights starting July 18 from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. and concluding July 19 from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. for overhead sign repairs. The lane width on the ramp will be restricted to five metres.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes, if possible and are asked to obey all signs, flag persons and other traffic control devices.
