Chip sealing starts on Highway 28 east of Bonnyville

Bonnyville... Twelve kilometres of Highway 28 are scheduled for seal coat construction on July 18. The section extends from Bonnyville to east of Fort Kent. Chip seal coat construction involves the application of a durable surface to the roadway. Work is expected to be completed by July 20, weather permitting.

Pilot vehicles will guide traffic through construction where the highway speed is reduced to 50 kilometres per hour. Motorists are asked to use caution in these areas and to obey all signs and flag persons.
