Paving starts on Highway 43 near Sangudo

Sangudo... Motorists can expect lane closures and delays to accommodate paving on the four-lane portions of Highway 43 between Sangudo and Glenevis.

The work begins July 30 and is expected to last for seven weeks, weather permitting. In addition to paving, the work includes ditch re-grading, line painting and installation of guardrail and delineators. Cost of the paving and improvements is approximately \$9.5 million.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines are doubled for speeding through construction zones when workers are present.
