Construction reduces lanes on Highway 2 north of Grande Prairie

Grande Prairie... Construction work at the intersection of Highway 2 and Township Road 723 north of Grande Prairie will start Aug. 23. The work will include installing signal lights and adding double left turning lanes for north and southbound traffic.

The construction zone will extend from north of the Highway 43 and Highway 2 interchange to Clairmont. Lane reductions for north and southbound traffic will occur on Highway 2 as required. Work is expected to be complete by Oct. 15, weather permitting. The cost of the intersection improvements is approximately \$2.4 million.

Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag persons.
