Minister Ouellette to promote Alberta at World Road Congress in Paris

Congress will showcase Alberta's road construction and engineering sector

Edmonton... Infrastructure and Transportation Minister Luke Ouellette will join his federal and several provincial counterparts on a Canadian trade mission to the 23rd World Road Congress, September 16 - 21.

"This congress will be a great opportunity for me to promote and showcase Alberta's road construction and engineering sector," said Ouellette. "I am also interested in exchanging ideas and lessons learned on road financing."

Many countries, including Canada, will set up pavilions in a trade show to promote products, services and knowledge in the road industry.

Participating in the Congress supports Premier Ed Stelmach's plan to build a stronger Alberta by providing and gathering international input valuable in the province's road construction and engineering sector. Other priorities for the government are to govern with integrity and transparency, improve Albertans' quality of life, manage growth pressures and promote safe and secure communities.

The estimated cost of travel, food and accommodations for Ouellette and one staff member is approximately \$19,000.
