Highway 750 north of High Prairie sealed with chips

High Prairie... More than 15 kilometres of Highway 750 from south of Gift Lake to Utikoomak Lake Reserve is scheduled for seal coat construction starting Sept. 27, weather permitting. An additional two kilometres of Highway 750 north of Highway 2 to the Grouard Mission is also scheduled for seal coat construction starting Sept. 27. Seal coat construction involves applying a wearing surface to the roadway. Work will be completed by Oct. 3, weather permitting.

Pilot vehicles will guide traffic through construction where the highway speed is reduced to 50 kilometres per hour. Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and to obey all signs and flag persons.
