Highway 37 approximately three kilometres west of Highway 28A will be closed Oct. 21 for railway crossing repair between 6 a.m. and 8 p.m., weather permitting. The highway will be closed between Range Roads 234 and 235. Traffic will be detoured onto the local gravel roads.
