Detour work closes lane on Calgary's Deerfoot Trail this weekend

Calgary... Motorists are advised that the right-hand lane of northbound Deerfoot Trail will be closed December 8 and 9 between Country Hills Boulevard and Highway 566 (the Balzac interchange). The lane closure is effective from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day. The speed limit has been reduced to 80 km/hr through this area due to the construction activity.

The closure accommodates construction of detour lanes, which are part of the Deerfoot Trail-Stoney Trail interchange project.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
