Traffic reduced to one lane on Highway 893 east of Heinsburg

Heinsburg... Starting Feb. 4, traffic will be reduced to one lane for all hours of the day on the Highway 893 bridge over the North Saskatchewan River east of Heinsburg.

The lane reduction accommodates steel girder repairs, weld repairs, and substructure bridge work. The \$1.5-million project will be completed Aug. 21, weather permitting.

Prior to Feb. 4, lane reductions had been in effect during daylight hours only.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people.
