Major bridge repairs begin on Highway 33 near Fort Assiniboine

Fort Assiniboine... Major bridge repairs will begin March 19 on Highway 33 over the Athabasca River south of Fort Assiniboine, located approximately 160 kilometres northwest of Edmonton. The work involves lifting the bridge structure, replacing the bridge supports, and completing concrete repairs at a cost of approximately \$80,000. Traffic will be reduced to one lane during daylight hours with occasional bridge closures lasting approximately 15 minutes. Work will be complete March 31, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people.
