Bridge work reduces lanes on 64 Avenue N in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect lane closures and speed reductions on the 64 Avenue N bridge over the Deerfoot Trail.

Starting April 29, bridge deck rehabilitation work begins on 64 Avenue North and will affect both the westbound and eastbound lanes. Traffic will be reduced to two narrow lanes westbound and one narrow lane eastbound. The speed limit will be reduced to 40 km/h through the construction zone. Work will be completed by Sept. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes during the project.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
