Bridge repairs begin on Highway 40 south of Grande Prairie

Grande Prairie... Bridge repairs will begin May 7 at the Wapiti River on Highway 40 south of Grande Prairie, resulting in lane reductions. The bridge will be reduced to one lane with a width of four metres. The project involves the replacement of deck joints and other repairs. The total project cost, including deck replacement in 2007 is \$1.6 million. Work is expected to be completed by June 13, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs, flag people and traffic control devices.
