Highway repair work set to begin near Grande Prairie

Grande Prairie... Highway 40 south of Grande Prairie is scheduled for spray patching starting May 16 from the Wapiti River to the south city limits.

Highway 43 east of Grande Prairie is also scheduled for spray patching starting May 17 from Beaverlodge to east of Highway 724.

Work on both projects will be completed by May 23, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
