REVISED Major construction work begins on Dunvegan Bridge north of Grande Prairie

Grande Prairie... Major construction work will begin April 15 on the Dunvegan suspension bridge on Highway 2 between Rycroft and Fairview. Traffic on the bridge will be reduced to one lane. As the remaining open lane will be reduced in width to *3.4 meters*, oversized vehicles or wide loads will not be permitted and will be redirected according to their size to bridge crossings on Highway 2 at Peace River and Highway 986 north of Peace River.

The lane closure and lane reduction will be in effect until Oct. 31. Bridge construction will continue in spring 2009 and traffic will be reduced to one lane until fall 2009. The project involves the replacement of the concrete bridge deck at a cost of \$17.8 million. Traffic lights located on either side of the bridge will direct traffic for the duration of construction. Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs, traffic signals and flag people.
