Bridge repairs reduce lanes on Highway 16A near Spruce Grove

Spruce Grove... Bridge repairs will begin May 21 on Highway 16A over the CN railway near Spruce Grove. Traffic will be reduced to one lane during daylight hours in both the eastbound and westbound directions, with occasional bridge closures lasting approximately 15 minutes. The project includes replacement of the concrete bridge deck and minor bridge repairs at a cost of \$3.4 million. Work is expected to be completed by Sept. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
