Repaving set to begin on Highway 63 north of Grassland

Grassland... Repaving work on 70 kilometres of Highway 63 from Highway 55 to north of Lyle Creek is scheduled to begin May 25. Work will be restricted to daylight hours and the posted speed limit will be reduced at various locations from 100 km/h to 80km/h and 50 km/h within the construction zone. Work will commence north of Lyle Creek and proceed southward toward Highway 55 throughout the summer. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of October, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
