Interchange work closes Calgary's Barlow Trail for a month

Calgary... Motorists are advised that Barlow Trail SE in Calgary will be closed for a month to accommodate construction near the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail interchange with Deerfoot Trail.

Starting June 2, Barlow Trail SE will be closed from Peigan Trail SE to 50 Avenue SE to accommodate widening and reconstruction work. The road re-opens to traffic on June 30, weather permitting. Traffic will be detoured to 50 Avenue SE and 25 Street SE.

The work on Barlow Trail SE is part of a larger project to upgrade the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail intersection and modify the on-ramp to southbound Deerfoot Trail from Peigan Trail. The overall project will be completed in October 2008, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
