## Roundabout paving causes major delays at Sylvan Lake

*Sylvan Lake...* Motorists can expect major delays at the junction of Highways 11A and 20 at Sylvan Lake.

Starting May 29, the new roundabout at the junction of the two highways will undergo paving and related work. Traffic will be reduced, alternately, to one-way through the construction zone for about one month. Motorists are strongly encouraged to use alternate routes as delays will be significant.

The roundabout and intersection work will be completed by June 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
