Bridge replaced on Highway 2 north of Athabasca

Athabasca... Traffic on Highway 2 over Baptiste Creek, approximately 17 kilometres north of Athabasca, will be detoured onto a temporary bridge structure between June 11 and Oct. 15, weather permitting. The existing bridge built in 1971 will be replaced with a new permanent bridge structure at a cost of \$4.3 million.

The speed limit within the construction zone will be reduced to 30 km/h. Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. In construction zones, when workers are present, fines for speeding in these areas will be doubled.
