Grant MacEwan Bridge repairs set to begin in Fort McMurray

Fort McMurray... Minor bridge repairs on the Grant MacEwan Bridge over the Athabasca River are scheduled to begin June 16 on Highway 63 southbound in Fort McMurray. The work will include pot hole repairs on the deck surface.

Traffic disruptions will be limited to night time hours between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Work is scheduled to be completed by June 20, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
