Twinned lanes set to open on Highway 2 near Sexsmith

Sexsmith... The 10-kilometres of newly twinned lanes on Highway 2 near Sexsmith will open to traffic June 14.

Northbound and southbound lanes on Highway 2 will be closed at approximately 1 p.m. for 30 minutes to complete line painting. Emergency vehicles will continue to have access through the construction zone.

Pilot vehicles will lead traffic on the newly opened southbound and northbound twinned lanes.

In the 24 hours following the opening, flag people will be on hand to assist the public in driving through the area. Electronic message boards have been posted 3 kilometres in advance of the twinned section to inform motorists of the change in traffic flow.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people.
