Intersections convert to four-way stops north of Lamont

Lamont... Motorists are advised that Highway 831's junctions with Highways 29 and 45 will become four-way stops.

Sign installation, road painting, and related work are expected to start the first week of July and the four-way stops will be in effect by or before July 11, weather permitting.

Currently, northbound and southbound traffic on Highway 831 is required to stop while eastbound and westbound traffic on both Highways 29 and 45 have the right-of-way at the two intersections.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
