Bridge replacement reduces lanes on Highway 16 in Edson

Edson... Motorists are advised that Highway 16 over Bench Creek in Edson will be reduced to two, 4.5-metre-wide lanes, starting July 7.

At times, the highway will be reduced to a single 4.5-metre-wide lane. The speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/h throughout the construction zone.

The lane reductions accommodate replacement of the bridge over the creek. The \$1.7-million project will be completed by Oct. 31, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
