Interchange work reopens Calgary's Barlow Trail

Calgary... Motorists are advised that Barlow Trail SE in Calgary will be reopened during the afternoon of July 11.

The road had been closed between Peigan Trail SE and 50 Avenue SE for the past six weeks.

The work on Barlow Trail SE is part of a larger project to upgrade the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail intersection and modify the on-ramp to southbound Deerfoot Trail from Peigan Trail. The overall project will be completed in October 2008, weather permitting.

Motorists should still use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
