## Rail crossing repairs close Highway 24 southeast of Calgary

*Carseland*... Motorists are advised to expect delays during the closure of Highway 24 west of Carseland to complete rail crossing repairs.

Starting at 6 a.m. July 28, crews will repair a rail crossing on Highway 24 for approximately 12 to 15 hours. Traffic will be detoured onto Highways 901 and 817.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
