Rail crossing repairs close Highway 44 northwest of Edmonton

Alcomdale... Motorists are advised to expect delays during the closure of Highway 44 at Alcomdale to complete rail crossing repairs.

Starting at 6 a.m. Aug. 14, crews will repair a rail crossing on Highway 44 until approximately 10 p.m. Large vehicles and trucks will be detoured to Highways 642, 2 and 651. A detour on local gravel roads will be available for light trucks and cars.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
