Klondyke Ferry north of Barrhead closes for a day

Vega... The Klondyke Ferry on the Athabasca River will be closed for most of the day Aug. 12 for repairs.

The ferry takes Highway 661 traffic over the Athabasca River near the Village of Vega. The repairs begin at 7 a.m. on Aug. 12 and the ferry should be back in operation by 5 p.m. the same day.

Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes such as Highways 33 or 769.
