Calgary's Scenic Acres Link closes for two months

Calgary... Motorists are advised that a portion of Scenic Acres Link NW in Calgary will close for two months to accommodate ring road construction.

The closure begins Sept. 2 and affects the entire length of Scenic Acres Link NW from Scurfield Drive NW to Stoney Trail NW. The closure accommodates construction of a Stoney Trail detour around the Scenic Acres Link NW interchange site and a temporary Stoney Trail/Scenic Acres Link intersection.

Motorists are advised to use Nose Hill Drive NW as an alternate route during the closure.

Scenic Acres Link NW is expected to re-open in early November, weather permitting. At this time, the Stoney Trail detour and temporary Stoney Trail/Scenic Acres Link intersection will open to traffic and be used until the fall of 2009 when the interchange is expected to open to traffic.

Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and obey all detour signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
