Calgary's Barlow Trail SE closes for paving

Calgary... Motorists are advised that alternating closures of Barlow Trail SE in Calgary will occur this weekend to accommodate paving work near the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail interchange with Deerfoot Trail.

On Sept. 13, southbound Barlow Trail SE will be closed for one day from Peigan Trail SE to 50 Avenue SE. On Sept. 14, northbound Barlow Trail SE will be closed for one day from Peigan Trail SE to 50 Avenue SE. Traffic will be detoured to 50 Avenue SE and 25 Street SE. The closures are dependent on weather.

The work on Barlow Trail SE is part of a larger project to upgrade the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail intersection and modify the on-ramp to southbound Deerfoot Trail from Peigan Trail SE. The overall project will be completed in October, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding through construction zones are doubled when workers are present.
