Interchange work disrupts traffic on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect delays and detours on the eastern portion of 16 Avenue NE (Trans Canada Highway 1) to accommodate interchange construction.

The delays and detours will occur Oct. 14, 15, 16, and 17 between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., weather permitting. The delays and detours affect both eastbound and westbound traffic on 16 Avenue NE between 68 Street NE and 84 Street NE

Eastbound traffic will be detoured south on 68 Street NE, east on 17 Avenue SE, north on 84 Street NE and back to 16 Avenue NE. Westbound traffic will be detoured north on 100 Street NE (Range Road 285), west on McKnight Boulevard NE, south on 68 Street NE and back to 16 Avenue NE.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes during the dates and times mentioned above. Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, pilot vehicles and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
