Highway 63 twinning south of Fort McMurray set to open in stages

Fort McMurray... The first 13 kilometres of Highway 63 twinning south of Fort McMurray between Highway 69 and north of Highway 881 will open to traffic Oct. 20. The remaining 3 kilometres of twinning near Highway 881 is expected to be completed and open to traffic in approximately three weeks, weather permitting.

Northbound and southbound lanes on Highway 63 will be closed on Oct. 20 at 9 a.m. for approximately 20 minutes to complete line painting. Pilot vehicles will lead traffic on the first section of the newly twinned lanes.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people.
