Bridge construction closes lanes on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect overnight lane closures on Calgary's Deerfoot Trail near the Stoney Trail interchange site between Country Hills Boulevard and Highway 566.

The right-hand lane of northbound Deerfoot Trail will be closed between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. on Oct. 20. The right-hand lane of southbound Deerfoot Trail will be closed between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. on Oct. 21. Both closures are subject to weather conditions.

The closures accommodate installation of overhang brackets on bridge structures near the Deerfoot Trail-Stoney Trail interchange site.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
