Paying closes portions of Barlow and Peigan Trails in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists are advised that paving work will close portions of Barlow Trail SE and Peigan Trail SE in Calgary.

The closures will occur for one day on Oct. 26, weather permitting. The closures affect: southbound Barlow Trail SE exit from Deerfoot Trail; northbound Barlow Trail SE from 50 Avenue SE to Peigan Trail SE; and eastbound Peigan Trail SE from Barlow Trail SE to 25 Street SE.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes such as 17 Avenue SE. Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.

This paving work is part of a larger project to upgrade the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail intersection and modify the on-ramp to southbound Deerfoot Trail from Peigan Trail. Visit www.transportation.alberta.ca/bargp.htm for more information and to view a plan of the construction work.
