Bridge construction closes lanes on Deerfoot Trail

Calgary... Motorists can expect overnight lane closures on Calgary's Deerfoot Trail near the Stoney Trail interchange site between Country Hills Boulevard and Highway 566.

The left-hand lane of both northbound and southbound Deerfoot Trail will be closed overnight on Oct. 27 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather permitting. Two lanes of traffic in both directions will remain open at all times.

The closures accommodate installation of blankets and tarps for concrete pouring on bridge structures near the Deerfoot Trail-Stoney Trail interchange site.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
