Calgary's Scenic Acres Link NW re-opens to traffic

Calgary... Motorists are advised that a portion of Scenic Acres Link NW in Calgary will re-open to traffic on Oct. 30.

Scenic Acres Link NW will re-open from Scurfield Drive NW to Stoney Trail NW. The road had been closed since September to accommodate construction of a Stoney Trail detour around the Scenic Acres Link NW interchange site and a temporary Stoney Trail/Scenic Acres Link NW intersection.

This Stoney Trail detour and temporary Stoney Trail/Scenic Acres Link NW intersection will be used until the fall of 2009 when the interchange is expected to open to traffic.

Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and obey all detour signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
