Construction disrupts traffic on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect lane closures on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary to accommodate construction activities.

On Oct. 31, the westbound lanes of 16 Avenue NE will be closed on an alternating basis between 84 Street NE and 68 Street NE. At least one westbound lane will remain open at all times. The closures are in effect between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. that day to accommodate installation of tarps and blankets for a future concrete pour.

On Nov. 1, the right-hand eastbound lane of 16 Avenue NE will be closed between 84 Street NE and 100 Street NE (Range Road 285). The closure is in effect between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. that day to accommodate asphalt saw-cutting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
