Bridge work disrupts traffic on Highway 2 west of Slave Lake

Slave Lake... Motorists can expect speed reductions on Highway 2 over Canyon Creek, approximately 25 kilometres west of Slave Lake, to accommodate construction activities for a bridge culvert replacement. The speed limit within the construction zone will be reduced to 80 kilometres per hour. Construction is scheduled to begin on Jan. 15 and is expected to finish by Feb. 7, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
