Bridge work disrupts traffic on Highway 55 east of Athabasca

Athabasca... Motorists can expect speed and lane-width reductions on Highway 55 over Pine Creek, approximately 20 kilometres east of Athabasca.

The reductions accommodate a \$2.1-million bridge replacement project. Traffic will be detoured onto a single-lane temporary bridge with a 4.2-metre width between Feb. 9 and May 31, weather permitting. The speed limit within the construction zone will be reduced to 30 km/h.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
