Construction disrupts traffic on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect periodic lane closures on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary to accommodate construction activities.

Starting Feb. 9, traffic will be reduced at various times to one lane in each direction on 16 Avenue NE between 68 Street NE and 84 Street NE. The closures will occur between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. daily until Feb. 14, weather permitting. The closures accommodate overhead bridge work at the Stoney Trail/16 Avenue NE interchange site.

Also starting Feb. 9, the right-hand eastbound lane on 16 Avenue NE will be closed between 84 Street NE and 100 Street NE. The closure will occur between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Feb. 9 and Feb. 10, weather permitting. The closure accommodates pile driving on the west abutment of the CN railway overpass.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
