Construction disrupts nighttime traffic on Southwest Anthony Henday

Edmonton... Motorists can expect nighttime disruptions on Anthony Henday Drive at Rabbit Hill Road to accommodate overhead sign construction.

Construction is scheduled for March 10 and 11 on the eastbound lanes and March 16 and 17 on the westbound lanes, weather permitting. During construction, traffic will be reduced to one lane between 10 p.m. and 3 a.m. A total closure of Anthony Henday is scheduled each night for approximately 30 minutes prior to 2 a.m., while the overhead structure is raised into place.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
