Signal switchover interrupts Calgary intersection

Calgary... Motorists can expect delays and traffic disruptions at the intersection of 17 Avenue SE and 84 Street SE in Calgary.

The disruptions take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on April 17 to accommodate switching to and testing newly-installed signals at the intersection. Police will direct traffic at the intersection during these hours and traffic may be stopped for short periods. Motorists are encouraged to use other routes during these hours.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
