84 Street NE intersection permanently closes in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists are advised that the intersection of 84 Street NE and 16 Avenue NE will permanently close on May 3 at noon.

The permanent closure ensures the safe operation of the new Stoney Trail NE interchange at 16 Avenue NE.

Access options for 84 Street NE are as follows:

- To access northbound 84 Street NE from 16 Avenue NE, motorists will drive east to 100 Street NE (Range Road 285), north to 32 Avenue NE and then west to 84 Street NE.
- To access southbound 84 Street NE from 16 Avenue NE, drivers will go east to 100 Street (Range Road 285), south to 17 Avenue SE and then west onto 84 Street SE.
- Access to 84 Street NE between McKnight Boulevard NE and 16 Avenue NE will be available via 32 Avenue NE from 100 Street NE (Range Road 285) and the addition of a newly built service road connecting 84 Street NE to McKnight Boulevard NE on the south side.
- A gated emergency access route to the south of 16 Avenue NE will be available for emergency vehicles ONLY to access Chateau Estates Mobile Home Park.

Road improvements and new signals will be installed prior to the closure of the intersection of 84 Street NE and 16 Avenue NE. These include:

- 100 Street NE (Range Road 285) paved and open between Country Hills Boulevard NE and 17 Avenue SE.
- New intersection built at 16 Avenue NE and 100 Street NE (Range Road 285).
