Paving disrupts traffic on Highway 3 in Lethbridge

Lethbridge... Motorists can expect periodic lane closures and other disruptions on sections of Highway 3 (Crowsnest Trail) through Lethbridge.

Pavement milling and inlay work begins May 5 on selected sections of Highway 3 from its junction with Highway 25 to its junction with Highway 4. The work will be completed by mid-June, weather permitting. The lane closures will occur during daylight hours Monday through Saturday for the duration of the project.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
