Sign installation closes lanes on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect periodic lane closures on the northern portion of Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

The closures begin May 4 and affect both northbound and southbound Deerfoot Trail between Country Hills Boulevard and the Highway 566 interchange. The lane closures accommodate drilling and concrete pouring for overhead sign structures. At least two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times. The closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. until May 9, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
